- JCOC – Erica Turner – Discussed feeding programs that support the community, ongoing affordable housing project, and opportunities to help JCOC through volunteering.
- VBCDC – Tanisha Davis – Discussed VBCDC’s impact on community in affordable housing, housing and wraparound services they provide, and partnerships they maintain in the community.

CoC Lead Agency Updates – Pam Shine

- Community of One update – Call Community of One meeting back to discuss the consolidated information gathered from the initial forum and establish a plan of action.
- Hunger and Homeless week – November 14-18; The BEACH Community Partnership website will highlight agencies. Communication staff will reach out to selected agencies to gather input.
- Forums originally planned during Hunger and Homeless week will tentatively take place in January.
- HRC will host a Landlord Engagement Forum, open to landlords partnered with the HRC, and BEACH members and their partnerships. The forum will facilitate conversation on HRC programs and funding opportunities for housing, challenges to housing and rentals, and to assess the intersection of needs between the HRC and landlords throughout the community.

Oceanfront Outreach Coalition – Dallas Stamper (On behalf of Mandi Cutchins)

- Discussed by-name list and outreach efforts in the Oceanfront. Provided information regarding Winter Shelter: pre-registration has begun, and winter shelter starts November 23rd.

VB Home – Erin Walker

- Over 65,000 was allocated in awards and 13 organizations applied to the grant.
- Grant awardees: Begin Again Foundation, LIFT Fitness Foundation, Moms on a Mission, PIN Ministries, Samaritan House, VBCDC, Virginia Beach Education Foundation, Virginia Supportive Housing.
- Grant window opens June-August annually.
- November 19th, 10-12, collection drive event as part of Hunger and Homeless week.
